What's a REFRACTION?

A REFRACTION is a diagnostic procedure that measures the power in your eye's natural lens. It also helps the doctor determine if your visual complaints are due to a medical condition or simply a need for new glasses. When glasses are needed, the refraction calculates the power of correction that is needed to best improve your vision.

The REFRACTION is normally performed as part of a comprehensive dilated eye exam.

Medicare and other medical insurances DO NOT PAY for this procedure. The refraction fee is the responsibility of the patient. Payment is due at the time of services, in addition to your co-pay or co-insurance.

We will file all of your charges to your insurance, including the refraction fee. We will, of course, give you a refund should your insurance pay for the procedure.
